This is the first time I had visitation by anyone. The majority of my family lives in Minnesota.

I learned over the weekend that I was full of head knowledge, and not of the heart. Love is a word not often said and rarely felt here. The flood of emotions... over the last four days have truly been life changing.

I had the greatest time of my life! It is better than going to Disney Land!

I learned three things that I will take with me my whole life:

3. I am 6 foot 4 inches, 285 pounds, and I'll cry when I want to.

The thing I will remember most is the beautiful colorings from the kiddos. They made every meal so special

I've been incarcerated for 19 and ½ years and this was the greatest weekend of my time in prison.

I accepted Christ in my life for the first time in my life....this Kairos Weekend has been the most loving weekend I ever had in my 51 years living on Earth.
