GATE LIST CONFIRMATION

You are on the approved entry list for the Wainwright Kairos Closing Ceremony. Please review this information carefully before going to Wainwright.

BEFORE YOU LEAVE HOME:

- Do not bring any drugs, knives, tobacco products, weapons of any kind or any other contraband onto TDCJ property (including the parking lot). Cars are subject to search.
- **Dress modestly and comfortably. You will be searched at the gate. Abide by the following dress code:**
 - No shorts, T-shirts, sleeveless shirts or revealing blouses. Shirts should have a collar.
 - No logos, emblems, insignias, symbols, statements, or "colors" of any kind on your clothes (no team jerseys and caps)
 - No open-toe shoes or dangling earrings and no earrings on men.
 - Wear colored clothes (not white - inmates wear all white).

GETTING THERE:

EASIEST ROUTE (32 miles from I-45 Exit 113): SH-19 19 miles to Trinity; left at FM-230; 13 miles to Wainwright.

AT THE GATE:

- Be at the gate by 2:30. The visitors will enter together. Late arrivals will not be allowed to attend.
- You must be at least 18 years old and have a photo ID to enter, preferably a driver's license.
- Do not bring your wallet, purse, cash, cell phones or pagers inside the unit. At the gate you will need only a photo ID (driver's license) and your car keys. Unauthorized items will cause denial of entry.

INSIDE WAINWRIGHT:

- Do not give anything to an inmate or take anything from an inmate. Do not deliver a message for an inmate to someone outside of the prison. Do not exchange any information (such as your phone number or address).
- At the ceremony there will be over 200 inmates in attendance that have all attended a Kairos weekend. Their numbers might be intimidating but there is no reason for concern. They are Christians celebrating the commitments of new "brothers in white." Their attendance has been approved by the chaplain and the warden.
- After the ceremony the visitors will leave first. The inmates will be mingling with the new Kairos brothers and the Kairos volunteer team. The inmates are not allowed to leave the building.
- Kairos has never experienced any violence at Wainwright.

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR WAINWRIGHT CLOSING


- (Please print the attached dashboard document to help traffic flow at gate)

At the gate by the road tell the guard that you are going to the Kairos Closing Ceremony. It might be enough to just say "KAIROS".

From the front gate at FM-230 to the prison is about two miles. The road ends at the parking lot. Park anywhere that is not marked as reserved or for staff.

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- *Lock your car.* The chance that your car will be broken into is *extremely remote* but the prison rules require that the cars be locked.
- Leave *everything* in the car except a *photoID* and your *car keys*. Unauthorized items will cause denial of entry. No phone - no money - no wallet - no purse.
- The photo ID should be your *driver's license* because that is the number beside your name on the entry list.
